About this course

The media regularly report on Climate Change and Carbon Emissions. In May 2019 the States of Jersey declared a climate emergency and in 2022 approved a Carbon neutral roadmap aiming to reduce the islands emissions and achieve "Net zero" by 2050. In order to achieve this objective it will require every islander and every business to play their part.

Carbon Literacy is the knowledge and capacity required to create a positive shift in how we live, work and behave in response to climate change. This course provides the opportunity to learn about the science and impact of carbon emissions, how these are measured, what solutions are available and critically, what we can each do to reduce our emissions and encourage others to do the same.

This course helps position your business to contribute towards Jersey being recognised as Sustainable Island and a jurisdiction of choice for sustainable finance. In addition it will support your ESG strategy and demonstrate genuine commitment to being a force for good.

Organisations that have a Carbon Literate workforce can be accredited by the Project team as a 'Carbon Literate Organisation' (CLO).

Learners who have completed a day's worth of Carbon Literacy learning can be certified as 'Carbon Literate'

What will you cover?

The course covers topics including:





- The Why, What and How of carbon and climate change
- Greenhouse gases, and their relationship to weather and climate
- How climate change is likely to affect us in Jersey, the UK and globally
- Key terminology, including net zero; carbon neutral; carbon footprinting, and offsetting
- What we are already doing national policy and local action
- Scopes 1, 2 and 3
- Motivating others to act employee engagement
- Next steps making a pledge; setting targets; tools; offsetting; resources.
